Cassiobury from Prehistory to Public Park

Cassiobury was the seat of the Earls of Essex from the 17th century until it was sold in 1922 and Cassiobury House demolished.

The walk lasts 1.5 - 2 hours. We will cross the canal and walk up to Jacotts Hill, the highest point in the park. You will hear about prehistory and the history from monastic times to the 20th century (there's even a mention of 'Star Wars')

Starts from outside the Hub on the upper paved patio (above the splash pools).
